ORDER

On August 4, 1975, Cecil J. and Helen Snow, on August 4, 1975,
Donald L. and Theresa S. Gardner, on August 19, 1975, Clifton G. and Bertha
Fay Snow, on October 30, 1975, Donald R. and Janette Hoff, on October 30, 1975,
Vernon B. and Emma S. Momberg, on October 30, 1975, First National Bank of
Oregon, Portland, Oregon, on October 30, 1975, Rene F. and Jeanne M. Farwig,
on October 30, 1975, Dale C. and Mary J. Blumenthal, on December 18, 1975,
John D. Billodeau and on December 18, 1975, Donald N. and Mary Peterson
submitted affidavits that they are the owners and contract purchasers of a
water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have
abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the
same to be canceled.

On January 9, 1976, notice was given by certified mail in accordance with the provisions of ORS 540.631 to 540.650 to James A. and Grace Eckes, Helen L. Hewitt, Richard L. Roberts, and Hood River County Board of Commissioners as owners and/or occupants of the land to which a water right hereinafter described is appurtenant of the Water Resources Director's intention to cancel said right.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.54 cubic foot per second of the waters from Griswell Creek for the irrigation of 0.8 acre in NW_4^1 NE_4^1 , 0.3 acre in SW_2^1 NE_4^1 , 1.1 acres in NE_4^1 NW_4^1 , 1.4 acres in NE_4^1 SE_4^1 , 14.1 acres in NW_4^1 SE_4^1 , 2.9 acres in SW_4^1 SE_4^1 , 11.4 acres in SE_4^1 SE_4^1 , Section 5, and 11.5 acres in NE_4^1 NE_4^1 , Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 16, 1924, and is evidenced by

certificate of water right recorded at Page 20369, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.87 cubic foot per second of the waters of Griswell Creek for irrigation of 7.8 acres in NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, 15.6 acres in SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, 0.4 acre in SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 10 East, W.M., 24.1 acres in NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 12.3 acres in SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 7.2 acres in NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, 2.1 acres in SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, 0.3 acre in SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 5, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 16, 1924, is not in question in this proceeding.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

That part of the above described water right in question which is not subject to cancelation under the provisions of ORS 540.621 may be canceled under the provisions of ORS 540.641 which provides for the cancelation of the water right if no protest is filed within the 60 day period immediately following the notice. No protest having been filed against the proposed cancelation of the water right in question within the 60 day period immediately following the notice, the water right should be canceled under provisions of ORS 540.621 (1).

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.54 cubic foot per second of the waters of Griswell Creek for the irrigation of 0.8 acre in NW4 NE4, 0.3 acre in SW4 NE4, 1.1 acres in NE4 NW4, 1.4 acres in NE4 SE4, 4.6 acres in NW4 SE4, 2.9 acres in SW4 SE4,

11.4 acres in SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 5, and 11.5 acres in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 16, 1924, is canceled.
