ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. David Steffen filed an application to add a point of appropriation under Certificates 24371, 49073 and 59982. The Department assigned the application number T-9774.
- 2. The entirety of the first right is to be transferred as follows:

5. Application T-9774 proposes to add an authorized point of appropriation approximately 0.50 miles from the existing point of appropriation serving Certificates 49073 and 59982 and approximately 0.13 miles from the existing point of appropriation serving Certificate 24371 in the Little Pudding River Basin, tributary to the Pudding River:

- 6. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. Pumps, pipelines, and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The addition of a point of appropriation proposed in application T-9774 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-9774 is approved.
- 2. Water right certificates 24371, 49073 and 59982 are canceled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not involved in this transfer.
- 3. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 24371, 49073 and 59982 and any related decree.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same water source (alluvial sands and gravels) as the original points of appropriation.
- 5. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2006.
- 6. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2007.
- 7. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 8. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 9. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
