Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department’s procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On September 30, 2003, Columbia Empire Farms Inc. (R-2 Ranch) filed an application proposing additional points of diversion under Certificates 2229, 50363, 75966, 75967, 75968 and 79536. The Department assigned the application number T-9582.
2. On May 24, 2006, the applicant submitted a request to amend the application to reflect Columbia Empire Farm’s (R-2 Ranch) new internal numbering system for identifying the various points of diversion. The new numbering systems is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

3. On September 19, 2006, the applicant's agent removed 3.2 acres in the NE¼ NW¼, Section 3, T 9 S, R 15 E, W.M., under Certificate 79536.
4. On October 2, 2006, the applicant's agent added copies of crop-related purchases to the affidavit of use.
5. On November 13, 2006, the applicant's agent corrected the application's description of the authorized point of diversion for Certificate 50363.

10. Transfer Application T-9582 proposes to add seven points of diversion. The proposed additional points of diversion identified as POD 1, POD 2, POD 3 and POD 4, are all more than 1000 feet upstream from the authorized point of diversion. 23. Notice of the application for transfer was published on November 4, 2003, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice. However, the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife did request inclusion of a condition requiring installation of proper fish screens.
24. On December 15, 2006, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing approval of Transfer Application T-9582 and mailed a copy to the applicant and the applicant's agent. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Departments weekly notice on December 19, 2006, and in the Madras Pioneer on January 3, January 10, and January 17, 2007 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the Department's weekly notice or to the newspaper notice.
25. Pumps, pipelines, and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
26. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
27. An instream water right, evidenced by Certificate 73189, exists for the reach of the river in which the authorized points of diversion would be moved upstream, and streamflows within the reach are frequently below the levels allocated under the instream water right. The proposed changes would not result in injury to the instream water right if conditioned to

prohibit the use of the proposed point of diversion (identified as the Dunlop diversion) when Trout Creek is receiving inflow from Hay Creek.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-9582, as conditioned, are consistent with the requirements of 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED

1. The additional points of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-9582 are approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 2229, 50363, 75966, 75967, 75968, 79536, and any related decree.
3. Water Right Certificates 2229, 50363, 75966, 75967, 75968 and 79536 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of these rights not involved in this transfer.
4. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2008**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
6. Water may be used at the additional points of diversion only when the same amount of water is available simultaneously at the original point(s) of diversion.
7. Use of additional upstream points of diversion under the right described by Certificate 50363 is allowed only while the instream water right, evidenced by Certificate 73189, is being met.
8. The use of additional points of diversion below the confluence of Antelope and Trout Creek under certificate 79536 does not authorize the use of Antelope Creek water and is limited to water available at the original point of diversion on Trout Creek (described in Finding of Fact #21).
9. The use of the proposed additional point of diversion POD 7 by the rights involved in this transfer application shall be prohibited when Trout Creek is receiving inflow from Hay Creek.
10. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgates or measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

11. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at each of the new points of diversion. The type and plans of the screens or by-pass devices must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction, and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.
12. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
