O R D E R

On July 5, 1962, notice was given by certified mail pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.631 to 540.650 to the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management, 710 N. E. Holliday Street, Portland 12, Oregon, owner of the land to which a water right hereinafter described is appurtenant, of the State Engineer's intention to cancel said right. There is no occupant on the subject property.

The water right in question is for the use of the waters of Tumalo Creek through the Columbia Southern Canal for domestic use and the irrigation of 33.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 15 South, Range 12 East, W.M. with a date of priority of September 1900, which right was established by decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County, now Deschutes County, entered May 1, 1911 in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Tumalo Creek, tributary of Deschutes River, and confirmed by certificate issued to A. L. Harader and recorded at page 70, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

No protest having been filed against the proposed cancelation of water right within the sixty-day period immediately following the notice, the water right should be canceled.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the water right evidenced by certificate of water right issued to A. L. Harader and recorded at page 70, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be and the same hereby is canceled.
