O R D E R


On January 6, 1977, Ruth Jacobsen submitted an affidavit that she is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that she has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right evidenced by certificate issued to Frank H. Jacobsen and recorded at Page 28836, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from Newton Creek, with a date of priority of October 12, 1959, for use in poultry buildings within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 28836, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
