ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8387 submitted by

SAM DINSDALE HC 61 BOX 9606 SILVER LAKE, OREGON 97638

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 72239, was perfected under Permit G-7242 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 4, 1977. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 34.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; LOT 1 (NW% NW%), SECTION 30, T 28 S, R 15 E, W.M.; at the NW CORNER OF SECTION 30, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 75808, was perfected under Permit G-8649 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 27, 1979. The right allows the use of WELL 2, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 6.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.052 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE% SW%, SECTION 20, T 28 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1400 FEET NORTH and 2380 FEET EAST from the SW CORNER, SECTION 20, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The applicant proposes to change the points of appropriation to:

SE% SE%, SECTION 25, T 28 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 1320 FEET NORTH and 1320 FEET WEST from the SE CORNER, SECTION 25.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2001.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
- 5. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.

Certificates 72239 and 75808 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued to confirm that portion of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes are received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
