O R D E R

WHEREAS, Permit No. 10408 was issued to the City of Hillsboro on December 31, 1931, granting the right to appropriate 15 second-feet of water from Patton Creek for municipal use in the City of Hillsboro, and


WHEREAS, Permit No. 10409 was issued to the City of Hillsboro on December 31, 1931, granting the right to the use of 10 second-feet of water from Gales Creek for municipal use in the City of Hillsboro, and

WHEREAS, Permit No. 10410 was issued to the City of Hillsboro on December 31, 1931, granting a right to the use of 5.0 second-feet of water from Scoggins Creek for municipal use in the City of Hillsboro, and

WHEREAS, the time limit for beginning of construction work has expired and an application for an extension of time has been filed by said City of Hillsboro,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for beginning of construction work under these permits be extended until December 31, 1933.
