ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6892 submitted by

MT. JEFFERSON FARMS
P.O. BOX 12708
SALEM, OREGON 97309.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 42011, was perfected under Permit 33677 with a date of priority of JUNE 14, 1968. The right allows the use of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER AND DETROIT RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, a tributary of the SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 160.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: RESERVOIR: SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 7, T 10 S, R 5 E, W.M.; RIVER: LOT 10 (NW¼ SE¼), SECTION 35, T 9 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 5540 FEET NORTH AND 2850 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SMALLMAN DLC 53, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2¼ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1625 and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-6300 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Oregon Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

RIVER: LOT 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 3, T 10 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 640 FEET SOUTH AND 910 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF STEWART DLC 54.


RESERVOIR: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 10 S, R 5 E, W.M.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 42011 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
