Authority

Findings of Fact

Background

- 1. On January 7, 2008, Tim Rust filed an application to temporarily change the place of use under Certificates 74795 and 31096 and water use Permit S-46499 for a period of five years. The Department assigned the application number T-10518.
 - . The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

- 8. Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published on January 22, 2008, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights and water use permit, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights and permit are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights and permit are present.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights or water use permit.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(6) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10518 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 13. The changes in place of use proposed in application T-10518 are approved.
- 14. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012 irrigation seasons.
- 15. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2012 irrigation season.

- 16. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 17. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 74795 and 31096 or water use Permit S-46499 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 18. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 74795 and 31096 and water use Permit S-46499.
- 19. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 20. The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 21. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 22. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificates 74795 and 31096 and water use Permit S-46499 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 74795 and 31096 and water use Permit S-46499.
