ORDER

On June 7, 1965, notice was given by certified mail in accordance with the provisions of ORS 540.631 to 540.650 to F. E. and Myrtle Molesworth, Route 1, Box 27, Mosier, Oregon and to Viret R. Brooks, Mosier, Oregon, as owners of record of the land to which a water right hereinafter described is appurtenant, of the State Engineer's intention to cancel said right.

The water right in question was established in the name of Edna 3. and Calvin Reed, successors in interest to Mac-A-Wauna Orchard Company, by Decree of the Circuit Court for Wasco County, entered June 20, 1928, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Mosier Creek and its Tributaries, a Tributary of Columbia River, and is for the use of not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second of the waters of Mosier Craek by means of a ditch and pumping system for power purposes, and for domestic and stock use and for the irrigation of 3.0 acres in the $W^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $W^{\frac{1}{4}}$, and 31.6 acres in the SWA NWA, Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1879.

No protest having been filed against the proposed cancelation of the water right in question within the sixty day period immediately following the notice, the water right should be canceled.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right to the use of not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second of the waters of Mosier Creek for power purposes, and for domestic and stock use and for irrigation of 3.0 acres in the NW and 31.6 acres in the SW NW, Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1879, is canceled.
