On September 29, 1971, Roy E. Olson, acting as Landscape Engineer for the Highway Division of the Department of Transportation, submitted an affidavit that the Oregon State Highway Commission is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that the Oregon State Highway Commission has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed

0.15 cubic foot per second of the waters from an unnamed spring and open

cut for the irrigation of:

5.0 acres in Lot 1 (NE% NW%) 6.9 acres in the NW% NE% Section 1, Township 40 South, Range 8 East, W.M.,

with a date of priority of March 31, 1936, and is evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 11667, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second of the waters of an unnamed spring and open cut for irrigation of:

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is GROERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second of the waters of an unnamed spring and open cut for the irrigation of:

5.0 acres in Lot 1 (NE% NW%) 6.9 acres in the NW% NE% Section 1, Township 40 South, Range 8 East, W.M.,

with a date of priority of March 31, 1936, is canceled.

It is FURTHER DRDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 11667, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a certificate be issued to J. H. Phipps covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second of the waters of an unnamed spring and open cut, a tributary of Klamath River, with a date of priority of March 31, 1936, for irrigation of:

28.5 acres in the NE% NE% 20.8 acres in the NW% NE% 1.7 acres in Lot 2 (SW% NE%) Section 1, Township 40 South, Range 8 East, W.M.

1.0 acre in the SWA NWA Section 6, Township 40 South, Range 9 East, W.M.,
