ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6518 submitted by

JOE BOCHSLER 1840 WILCO HIGHWAY MT. ANGEL, OREGON 97362.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 42309, was perfected under Permit G-3730 with a date of priority of JUNE 22, 1967. The right allows the use of water from A WELL, a tributary of ZOLLNER CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 70.6 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.55 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW\(\frac{1}{3}\) SECTION 35, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 130 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 35, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

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THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of water diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 42309 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
