ORDER

Notice was given by certified mail in accordance with the provisions of ORS 540.631 to 540.650 to Daryle Holt, 215 Fielder Lane, Grants Pass, Oregon, and Lawrence C. Wills and Patricia Wills, 2405 Hillside Drive, Eureka, California, owners of the land to which a certain water right is appurtenant, of the State Engineer's intention to cancel said right.

The water right in question is for the use of 0.405 cubic foot per second of the waters of Rogue River for the irrigation of 32.4 acres in Lot 3 ( $S_2^1$  SW $_2^1$ ), Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 6, 1913, and is evidenced by certificate recorded at page 2828, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

That part of the right confirmed by the above certificate for the use of the waters of Rogue River for the development of power is not in question as said right for the development of power was limited to a period of 40 years from the date of the priority of the right and has expired.

That part of the right confirmed by the above certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.407 cubic foot per second of the waters of Rogue River for the irrigation of 15.6 acres in Lot 3 ( $S_2^1$  SW $_2^1$ ) and 17.0 acres in Lot 4 ( $W_2^1$  SE $_2^1$ ), Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., is not in question.

No protest having been filed against the proposed cancelation of the water right in question within the sixty-day period immediately following notice, the water right should be canceled. NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.405 cubic foot per second of the waters of Rogue River for the irrigation of 32.4 acres in Lot 3 ( $S_2^1$  SW $_3^1$ ), Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 6, 1913, is canceled.
