Now at this time the above entitled matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of the Federal Land Bank of Spokane and for the approval of a change in place of use of water within the Squaw Creek Irrigation District and it appearing that by decree of the court for Crook County in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, water rights were recognized for the irrigation of 1.5 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, 8.5 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, 4.0 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, and 1.5 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 8, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M. with a date of priority of 1895, and for the irrigation of 4.5 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, 4.0 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, 14 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, and 4.0 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 8, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, and for the irrigation of 10 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 15 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, and 4.0 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 19, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1904, all of said lands belonging to the Federal Land Bank of Spokane.

That the applicant herein proposes to change the place of use of water from the above described lands to 10 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 5.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 0.5 acre in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, with date of priority of 1895, and 14.5 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, 7.0 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 19, all Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M., and 5.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 24, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W.M. with date of priority of November 11, 1895, and to 29 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 8, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with date of priority of 1904.

That all of said lands are within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek

Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said district has given its approval in writing to the proposed transfer and it further appearing that the change in place of use will inure to the benefit of the applicant in the production of crops and that such transfer will not be an injury to existing rights;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said change in place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved and the rights heretofore established shall become appurtenant to 10 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 5.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 0.5 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, with date of priority of 1895, and 14.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 7.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, all Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M., and 5.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W.M. with date of priority of November 11, 1895, and to 29 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with date of priority of 1904, PROVIDED that said water to be transferred shall be applied to said lands within one year from the date of this order, or within any extension of said time as the State Engineer, for good cause shown, may grant.
