ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6514 submitted by

RANDY W. PAJARI 18030 NW ROCKYFORD ROAD YAMHILL, OREGON 97148.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 56586, was perfected under Permit 41918 with a date of priority of MAY 12, 1977. The right allows the use of water from HUTCHCROFT CREEK, a tributary of NORTH YAMHILL RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION 11.3 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.145 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.14 cfs for irrigation, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW\(\frac{1}{2}\) SE\(\frac{1}{2}\), as projected within BIRDWELL DLC 37, SECTION 36, T 2 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1920 FEET NORTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 37, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW¼ SE¾ 7.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

NW% NE% 4.3 ACRES SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW\(\frac{1}{4}\) SE\(\frac{1}{4}\), SECTION 36, T 2 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1300 FEET NORTH AND 3100 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 37.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 56586 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
