Authority

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

Findings of Fact

- 1. The Knappa Water Association submitted a Water Management and Conservation Plan (plan) to the Water Resources Department (Department) on June 12, 2013. The required statutory fee for review of the plan was received by the Department on June 12, 2013. The plan was required by a condition set forth in the final order issued on August 3, 2010, approving an extension of time for Permit G-11676 and G-13427.
- 2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on June 18, 2013, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
- 3. The Department provided written comments on the plan to Knappa Water Association August 30, 2013. In response, Knappa Water Association submitted a revised plan on February 28, 2022, and the final revised plan on July 12, 2022.
- 4. The Department reviewed the revised plan and finds that the revised plan is consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Conclusion of Law

The Water Management and Conservation Plan by Knappa Water Association is consistent with the criteria in OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Duration of Plan Approval:

1. The Knappa Water Association, Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until April 15, 2033, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

Development Limitations:

2. The limitation of the diversion of water under Permit G-11676 established in the Final Order approving an Extension of Time for Permit G-11676 (issued on August 7, 2010) and the limitation for Permit G-13427 established in the Final Order Approving an Extension of Time for Permit G-13427 (issued on October 4, 2010) remains unchanged and is subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the Knappa Water Association remains authorized to divert only up to 0.0913 cubic foot per second (cfs) (out of the total permitted 45 gallons per minute(gpm) or (0.10 cfs)) of water under Permit G-11676, and only up to 0.089 cfs (out of a total permitted 0.156 cfs) under Permit G-13427.

Plan Update Schedule:

3. The Knappa Water Association shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (April 15, 2033) within ten (10) years and no later than October 20, 2032.

Plan Update Schedule:

4. The Knappa Water Association Water Management and Conservation plan is authorized until **April 20, 2033**, Knappa Water Association shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by **April 20, 2028** (five years), the Water Management and Conservation Plan is due by **October 20, 2032**.

Other Requirements for Plan Submittal:

5. The deadline established herein for the submittal of an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan (consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 086) shall not relieve the Knappa Water Association from any existing or future requirements for submittal of a Water Management and Conservation Plan at an earlier date as established through other final orders of the Department.
