Authority

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 14, 2016, the Department received an application for extension of time for Transfer Application T-10558.
- 2. The Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10558 on November 30, 2009. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 79, Pages 291-295. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2011.
- 3. A superseding final order was issued on August 31, 2010. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 81, pages 786-790. The order maintained the transfer completion date of October 1, 2011 and corrected a scrivener's error in the previous order.
- 4. The applicant has completed irrigation of 10.8 acres from the additional well, reported the water use and installed a totalizing flow meter. The applicant was unable to complete the changes because they did not measure the static water level of the well in the month of March.
- 5. To fully complete the change, the applicant needs to measure the static water level of the well in the month of March.
- 6. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2018.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10558.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes in place of use authorized by Transfer Application T-10558 shall be extended to October 1, 2018.
