## ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7943 submitted by

DAVID CORREA 76069 ECHO MEADOWS ROAD ECHO, OREGON 97826.

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County in the name of COURTNEY IRRIGATION COMPANY, tabulated in the name of T.G. SMITH. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is JANUARY 9, 1900.

The right allows the use of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 29.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic foot per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of the decree, if available at the authorized point of diversion: WESTLAND CANAL, SW% NE%, SECTION 21, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

 1.0 ACRE

SECTION 12

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to TEMPORARILY change the place of use to:

NW¼ SE¼ 11.7 ACRES SW¼ SE¼ 17.3 ACRES

SECTION 12

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

THIS TEMPORARY CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The change is temporary. the change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
- 2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water during the term of this order.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2000 irrigation season.
- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 5. The use of the remaining water rights described by the decree, tabulated in the name of T.G. Smith shall continue to in accordance with the terms and conditions of the decree.
