An affidavit was received from LARRY PARDUCCI, Mayor, and OTTO CASTER, Council President of City of Phoenix, authorized signors for City of Phoenix, the owner of certain land and the water rights appurtenant to it. The water right records show two rights as primary on this land. The water right from A WELL has been requested to be diminished from primary to supplemental.

The water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 74181, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The water right is for the use of 0.1 cubic foot per second from A WELL. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 27, 1973. The water right is for IRRIGATION of 8.0 ACRES.

The place of use of the water right is described as follows:

OAR 690-330-040(2) states: "Diminuation of a water right: A primary right may, at the request of the owner of the right, be diminished to a supplemental status to allow for a new primary right application from a more dependable source of water."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the water right described herein is diminished to SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 74181 is canceled and a new certificate be issued to confirm this order.
