IN THE MATTER OF THE CORRECTION OF THE DESCRIPTION OF LANDS ON WHICH CERTAIN WATER FROM MAIHEUR RIVER AND ORDER WARM SPRINGS CREEK SHALL BE USED BY PACIFIC LIVE STOCK COMPANY.

This matter coming on at this time for consideration, on the application of Pacific Live Stock Company, and it appearing:

That at a meeting of the State Water Board held on November 16, 1921, an order was entered allowing a transfer of water right to the Pacific Live Stock Company, one provision of said order being that before final certificate was issued by the Board covering the right transferred, the exact acreage to which it was desired that said right become appurtenant should be specified by said company; and that a statement specifying such acreage was thereafter filed. and approved by said board at a meeting held Feb. 9, 1922; that said Company has now filed an amended description and asks that same be substituted for said original specification; and it further appearing that no injury to other rights will be caused by such change and that same should be made, NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED, that the specification of lands as approved by said order of Feb. 9, 1922, be, and the same is hereby, revoked, and that the rights transferred by said order of November, 1921, shall be appurtenant to the following described lands:-
