Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6760 submitted by

STAN WEISHAAR 65001 OREGON HIGHWAY 237 LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 42978, was perfected under Permit G-4428 with a date of priority of November 13, 1968. The right allows the use of five wells, a tributary of the GRAND RONDE BASIN, for IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 986.6 ACRES. amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount beneficially used and shall not exceed 10.75 cubic feet per second, being 1.48 c.f.s. from No. 1, 3.30 c.f.s. from No. 2, 3.30 c.f.s. from No. 4, and 2.67 c.f.s. from No. 5 for irrigation of lands tabulated under well No. 5 to be made up by appropriation from wells 1 and 3 provided the quantity appropriated from well No. 3 shall not exceed 0.89 c.f.s. and the total quantity appropriated for these lands shall not exceed the limitations of the duty of water as fixed herein, if available at the original wells; #1-1350 feet North and 30 feet West from SE corner, Section 7, being within NE% SE%, Section 7, T 3 S, R 39 E, W.M., #2-1330 feet North and 670 feet West from SE corner, Section 5, being within NE¼ SE¼, Section 5, T 3 S, R 39 E, W.M., #3-2550 feet North and 1340 feet East from SW corner, Section 5, being within NE% SW%, Section 5, T 3 S, R 39 E, W.M.; #4-1400 feet North and 580 feet West from SE corner, Section 8, being within NE% SE%, Section 8, T 3 S, R 39 E, W.M.; #5-2700 feet North and 1470 feet West from SE corner, Section 6, being within SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 6, T 3 S, R 39 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acres, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

The portions of the water rights requested to be cancelled as described herein, are cancelled.

Certificates 34633 and 42978 are canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming this water right will be issued.
