Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 19, 2015, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the temporary changes proposed in Application T-12146. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 98, Page 281.
- 2. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2019 irrigation season.
- 3. The most recent use of water at the place of use authorized under the temporary transfer was during the 2015 irrigation season.
- 4. Willy Dinsdale, the owner of the lands to which the water right is appurtenant, submitted a written request that the temporary transfer be voluntarily terminated. As the owner of the lands, he is authorized to seek termination of the temporary transfer.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Temporary Transfer T-12146 is terminated. The use shall revert to the place of use authorized under Certificates 29769 and 31376. Water may not be used at the authorized place of use during the same season in which water was used under the Temporary Transfer.
