IN THE MATTER OF AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION, COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION, AND MAKE COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMITS NO. 10408 AND NO. 10410 IN THE NAME OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO.

ORDER

Extending Time Limits

The City of Hillsboro is the holder of Permit No. 10408 to appropriate 15.0 second-feet of water from Patton Creek for municipal use and Permit No. 10410 to appropriate 5.0 second-feet of water from Scoggins Creek for municipal use. The time for beginning construction as extended by the State Engineer expired October 1, 1942.

The city has advised the State Engineer that it is its desire to preserve the rights represented by these permits and has submitted an application for an extension of time in which to begin and complete the contemplated appropriations.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that the time limits for beginning of construction, completion of construction and complete application of water under these permits be and the same are hereby extended until October 1, 1945, October 1, 1946, and October 1, 1947, respectively.
