ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6288 submitted by

STANLEY J. AND MARLENE F. HARRIS 501 ROGUE RIFFLE DR. GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.97 ACRE.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 44959, was perfected under Permit 16661 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 5, 1945. This right is limited to 0.012 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion: LOT 2 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 26, T 35 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 20 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SEC 26, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the river.

The new point of diversion for the irrigation of 0.97 acre is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SEC 26, T 35 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 1200 FEET NORTH AND 170 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SEC 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.66 ACRE SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.66 ACRE SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

Certificate 44959 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
