E. E. Young on May 2, 1933, filed Application No. 14913, which is for permit to appropriate 20 second-feet of water from Secret Creek, Application No. 14914, which is for permit to appropriate 2 second-feet of water from Maple Creek, and Application No. 14915, which is for permit to appropriate 3 second-feet of water from Little Elkhorne Creek, for mining purposes. A protest to the approval of these applications was filed May 10, 1933, by the Oregon State Game Commission, which protest was made subject to withdrawal if the applicant should agree to control the deposit of mud into Rogue River and its tributaries to the satisfaction of the State Game Commission between the dates of April 15, and December 1, of each year.

The applicant under date of May 17, 1933, agreed to the stipulation of the Game Commission, and the protest having been withdrawn,

IT IS ORDERED that the applications be approved and permits issued.
