ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6489 submitted by

PAULINA RANCH, INC. P.O. BOX 46 PAULINA, OREGON 97751.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 61100, was perfected under Permit G-9255 with a date of priority of MAY 29, 1980. The right allows the use of water from WELL 2, a tributary of BEAVER CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 47.4 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.59 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW\(\frac{1}{2}\) SU\(\frac{1}{4}\), SECTION 3, T 17 S, R 23 E, W.M.; 3475 FEET SOUTH AND 500 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 61101, was perfected under Permit G-9256 with a date of priority of MAY 29, 1980. The right allows the use of water from WELL 1, a tributary of BEAVER CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 32.9 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.42 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) NE\(\frac{1}{2}\), SECTION 4, T 17 S, R 23 E, W.M.; 2250 FEET SOUTH AND 1420 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

The applicant also proposes to change the POINT OF APPROPRIATION for the lands from well 1 to:

NW\(\frac{1}{4}\) NW\(\frac{1}{4}\), SECTION 3, T 17 S, R 23 E, W.M.; WELL 2 - 3475 FEET SOUTH AND 500 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Ext. to 10 1994
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificates 61100 and 61101 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of these rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
