ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER 5474

On April 23, 1984, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Paul H. and Carole L. Hebb for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 51231, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of North Unit Irrigation District, describes a right which includes the use of water from Deschutes River, for irrigation of 2.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 0.2 acre in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 14.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 17.9 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, Township 12 South, Range 13 East, WM, with a date of priority of February 28, 1913. Said lands have a supplemental right under Certificate 51232.

Water for the said right is diverted through the North Unit Main Canal.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to transfer the right therefrom to a certain 1.9 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4 and 32.2 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, Township 12 South, Range 13 East, WM (Gary Dinkel).

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of North Unit Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use at a regular meeting.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1985.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change in place of use shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to North Unit Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 51231.
