Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- 1. On October 21, 2019, BROKEN SPUR RANCH LLC filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Certificates 53743, 82164, and 86784, to change the places of use under Certificates 2545, 53122, 53743, 82164, and 86784, and partial diminution of Certificates 53743, 82164, and 86784. The Department assigned the application number T-13276.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 29, 2019, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On May 3, 2022, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13276 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of June 3, 2022, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On August 3, 2022, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-13276 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on August 9, 2022, and in the East Oregonian newspaper on August 6, and 13, 2022, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 23. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 24. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13276.
- 25. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 26. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 27. All other application requirements are met.

Partial Diminishment of Water Rights

On October 21, 2019, affidavits and proof of ownership documents were submitted by Bentio Mendelez Jr., the affidavits propose the diminution of portions of Certificates 53743, 82164, and 86784 from Primary Irrigation to Supplemental Irrigation in accordance with 690-380-5120, as described in the findings below.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of diversion and change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13276 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000 and the diminished rights are diminished.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional points of diversion and change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13276 are approved. The portion of the rights that have been diminished are diminished to supplemental irrigation.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the places of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 2545, 53122, 53743, 82164, 86784, orders, and any related decree.
- 3. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a <u>totalizing</u> <u>flow meter</u>, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 4. Water right Certificates 2545, 53122, 53743, 82164, and 86784 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer and diminutions.

- 5. The portions of Certificates 53743, 82164, and 86784 as described in the findings are diminished to supplemental irrigation.
- The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
- 7. The former places of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2024. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
