
O R D E R

S. J. Taylor on April 11, 1933, filed Application No. 14900, for permit to appropriate 2 second-feet of water from East Fork of Jones Creek for mining purposes. A protest to the approval of this application was filed April 23, 1933, by the Oregon State Game Commission, which protest was made subject to withdrawal if the applicant should agree that mud and tailings would not be dumped into the Rogue River or any of its tributaries, between April 15 and December 1, of each year.

The applicant under date of May 11, 1933, agreed not to dump mud and tailings into the Rogue River between April 15 and December 1, of each year, and the protest having been withdrawn,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application be approved and a permit issued.
