On April 15, 1988, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Lonnie L. and Marlene D. Feigner for approval of a change in place of use of water from Crooked River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 51233, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of North Unit Irrigation District, describes a right which includes the use of water from Crooked River for irrigation of 3.0 acres in SE1/4 SE1/4 Section 4, Township 10 South, Range 14 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 18, 1968.

Water for said right is diverted through the Main Canal from a point located 590 feet North and 2,790 feet East from the West Quarter corner of Section 13, being within the SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 13, Township 14 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to transfer the water right therefrom to a certain 3.0 acres in SW1/4 NE1/4 Section 9, Township 10 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the proposed change place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the subject water right is hereby severed from the place of use described in Certificate 51233, and shall be beneficially used as authorized by this order on or before October 1, 1989.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change in place of use shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to the North Unit Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 51233.
