IN THE MATTER OF AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION, COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION, AND COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMIT NO. 3945 AND PERMIT NO. 7257, IN THE NAME OF THE CITY OF ASTORIA.

ORDER

EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The City of Astoria is the holder of Permit No. 3945, which grants a right to the use of 16.0 second-feet of water from Big Creek for domestic supplies, and Permit No. 7257, which grants a right to the use of 23.0 second-feet of water from Young's River for municipal purposes.

The City of Astoria has advised the State Engineer that the appropriations described under these permits have not been made, but it is its desire to preserve the rights for these developments.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that the time limits for the beginning of construction, completion of construction, and complete application of water under these permits be and the same are hereby extended until October 1, 1950, October 1, 1951, and October 1, 1952, respectively.
