## ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7007 submitted by

KRAMER FARMS 13318 DOMINIC RD NE MT ANGEL, OREGON 97362

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 60970, was perfected under Permit G-8952 with a date of priority of MAY 13, 1980. The right allows the use of A WELL (WELL 2) in the ZOLNER CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 116.3 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.45 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE% NW%, SECTION 18 T.6S., R.1E., W.M.; 1300 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 18, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The applicant proposes to ADD AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION located: NE% NE%, SECTION 13, T.6S., R.1W., W.M., 1900 FEET NORTH AND 870 FEET WEST FROM THE E% CORNER SECTION 13.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
