Background

- 1. On April 3, 2003, Lee Roy Horton filed an application to transfer the place of use and points of appropriation under Certificates 54250, 76578, and 76671. The Department assigned the application number T-9388.
- 2. On May 31, 2006, the map and application were amended with the approval of Bruce Estes, Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).
- 3. Philip Eide is the receiving landowner for a portion of land to be transferred under Certificates 76578 and 76671.
- 4. The first right to be transferred is as follows:

- 13. Notice of the application for transfer was published on April 15, 2003, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 14. On March 28, 2007, the Department issued a preliminary determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-9388 and mailed a copy to the applicant and receiving landowner. Additionally, notice of the preliminary determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on April 3, 2007, and in a local newspaper on April 19, April 26 and May 3, 2007, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the Department's weekly notice or to the newspaper notice.
- 15. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 16. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights is present.
- 17. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 18. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The changes in place of use and points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-9388 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The changes in place of use and points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-9388 are approved.
- 2. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 54250, 76578, and 76671.
- 3. Water Right Certificates 54250, 76578 and 76671 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing that portion of the rights evidenced by Certificates 76578 and 76671 not affected by this transfer.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 5. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2008.** A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 7. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water as part of these rights.
- 8. Prior to diverting water at the new points of appropriation, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 9. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
