That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 29 gallons of water per minute from a well located 320 feet North and 40 feet West from the Southeast corner of the NW4 NW4, Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., for the irrigation of 5.0 acres within the NW4 NW4, Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

That part of the claimed right described in said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 201 gallons per minute of water from a well located 320 feet North and 40 feet West from the Southeast corner of the NW_{4}^{1} , NW_{4}^{1} , Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., for the irrigation of 35 acres within the NW_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} , Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 29 gallons per minute of water from a well located 320 feet North and 40 feet West from the Southeast corner of the NW4 NW4, Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., for the irrigation of 5.0 acres within the NW4 NW4, Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., described in certificate of registration recorded at Page GR-1193, Ground Water Registration Record, is canceled.
