O R D E R


On March 28, 1980 Charles Fitzwater Baker submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 33501, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Robert E. Knight , and is for the use of not to exceed 0.026 cubic foot per second of water from Woods Creek and Knights Reservoir, with a date of priority of January 22, 1962, for supplemental irrigation of a certain 0.10 acre in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 4, and 2.9 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, both as projected within J. Wood D.L.C. No. 75, Township 12 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 33501, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
