ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

AND TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6424 submitted by

PHILLIP D. SCHLOSSER
61668 TAM MCARTHUR LOOP
BEND, OREGON 97702.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 68327, tabulated in the name of the McCall Estate, was perfected under Permit 25991 with a date of priority of APRIL 8, 1914. The right allows the use of the waters of CROOKED RIVER AND PRINVEVILLE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2223, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.40 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from the reservoir constructed under Permit R-2223, and shall be further required to have a contract between the landowner and the Bureau of Reclamation.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 11.0 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.0 ACRES
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 7.6 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.4 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.0 ACRES
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

The applicant and the Watermaster provided information that the point of diversion described on the water right certificate is used for only a portion of the land listed. At the time of the final proof survey, the land involved in the transfer was irrigated from, and the authorized point of diversion should be, Direct Diversion 48, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 22, T 14 S, R 14 E, WM; 1210 FEET NORTH AND 1050 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 22.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.
2. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 57614 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
