# Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

# **Findings of Fact**

### Background

1. On August 29, 2007, Philip R. Olson filed an application to change the place of use under Certificates 51799 and 51801. The Department assigned the application number T-10450.

2. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

**Certificate:** 51799 in the name of PHILIP R. OLSON (perfected under Permit S-38064)

Use: IRRIGATION of 26.3 ACRES

Priority Date: JULY 19, 1974

Rate: 0.31 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent

for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from

reservoir constructed under Permit R-6154.

- 5. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 4, 2007, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. On September 8, 2008, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10450 to the applicant. The cover letter for the draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of October 9, 2008, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 7. On January 6, 2009, the Department issued a preliminary determination proposing to approve Transfer T-10450 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the preliminary determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on January 13, 2009, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

# Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

8. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 9. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Application T-10450.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10450 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

# Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10450 is approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 51799 and 51801 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificates 51799 and 51801 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing the portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 5. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department. The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.
- 6. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2010. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 7. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
