ORDER

On October 21, 1986, Delbert and Barbara Hupp submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain water rights and the lands to which the water rights are appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water rights and request the same be canceled.

The water rights in question are:


- 1) for the appropriation of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre irrigated from Snow and Three Creeks for the irrigation of 0.9 acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 24.1 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and 14.6 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1891, as described by the certificate recorded at page 14786, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates;
- 2) for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.8 cubic foot per second of water from Three Creek, Snow Creek, and water stored under Permit R-701 in Big and Little Three Creek Lakes for the supplemental irrigation of 0.9 acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 24.1 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and 15.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM, with dates of priority of March 8, 1923 for Snow Creek and Three Creek and September 12, 1936 for reservoirs, as described by the certificate recorded at page 15360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates;
- 3) for the appropriation of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre irrigated from Snow and Three Creeks for the irrigation of 5.4 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1891, as allowed by the order approving Transfer B-152 recorded at page 196, Volume 33, Special Order Record of the Water Resources Director;
- 4) for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.1 cfs from Three Creek, Snow Creek, and water stored under Permit R-701 in Big and Little Three Creek Lakes for the supplemental irrigation of 5.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM, as allowed by the order approving Transfer B-152 recorded at page 196, Volume 33, Special Order Record of the Water Resources Director;

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water rights, being portions of the rights described by the certificates recorded at page 14786, Volume 12, page 15360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates and Transfer B-152, are canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificates of water right are canceled, and in lieu thereof new certificates be issued to describe the balance of water rights NOT involved in this proceeding.
