On August 22, 1956 R. B. Oliver of Box 215, Idleyld Route, Roseburg, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from North Umpqua River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at page 19656, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was issued to R. B. Oliver confirming a right under Permit No. 12340 to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River for the irrigation of 11.6 acres in the  $NW_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 15.6 acres in the  $SW_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 24.6 acres in the  $SE_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 0.4 acre in the  $NE_4^1$   $NW_4^1$  and 1.2 acres in the  $NE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with a date of priority of August 31, 1936. The point of diversion for the irrigation of these lands is located 70 feet south and 620 feet west from the east quarter corner of Section 15, and being within the  $NE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , said Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate said lands by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said pumping plant to be located 160 feet north and 1195 feet west from the east quarter corner of Section 15, and being within the  $SW_4^1$   $SE_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , said Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on applications for a change in point of diversion of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

It appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water, to-wit:

From a point located 70 feet south and 620 feet west from the east quarter corner of Section 15, and being within the  $NE_{4}^{1}$   $SE_{4}^{1}$ , said Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M.,

To a point to be located 160 feet north and 1195 feet west from the east quarter corner of Section 15, and being within the  $SW_4^1$   $SE_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , said Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M.,

for the irrigation of 11.6 acres in the  $NW_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 15.6 acres in the  $SW_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 24.6 acres in the  $SE_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , 0.4 acre in the  $NE_4^1$   $NW_4^1$  and 1.2 acres in the  $NE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , Section 15, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with a date of priority of August 31, 1936, be and the same hereby is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion made on or before October 1, 1957 or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the pumping plant and related works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the plans of the weir or other suitable device be approved by the watermaster of Douglas County, Oregon

before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.
