On December 18, 1975, John D. Billodeau submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and requests the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of the waters of Griswell Creek for domestic use within the NW4 SE4, Section 5, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1899, and is evidended by certificate of water right recorded at page 14959, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates in the name of Ziba Dimmick.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the use of the waters of Griswell Creek for stock use and the irrigation of 9.5 acres in the NW4 SE4, Section 5, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1899, is not in question in this proceeding.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of the waters of Griswell Creek for domestic use in the NW4 SE4, Section 5, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1899, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 14959, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a certificate be issued to John D. Billodeau covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the use of the waters of Griswell Creek, with a date of priority of 1899, for stock use and the irrigation of 9.5 acres in the NW SEZ, Section 5, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, W.M.
