Transfer Application 4051, in the name of Peter H. Koehler, proposed a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek under a certain right with a priority date of September, 1900, for irrigation of 1.0 acre in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 26, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered October 26, 1979, approving Transfer Application 4051, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979." An extension of time to October 1, 1982 in order to complete the project was subsequently allowed.

Based on the results of a survey conducted on August 29, 1985 by employes of the Water Resources Department, the applicant has irrigated 0.1 acre. Irrigation of the balance of 0.9 acre was not completed within the terms of the transfer, as extended, therefore, the right to irrigate 0.9 acre in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 26, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM, is lost.
