ORDER

On December 22, 1980, Robert B. Pokorny, Daniel J. Pokorny, and Edwin J. Pokorny submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26295, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank J. Pokorny, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second of water from Champoeg Creek, with a date of priority of November 14, 1951, for irrigation of a certain 21.0 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 4.6 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 1.8 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 19.1 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 14 and 7.6 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 15, all as projected within Rhoades DLC 101, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26295, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
