ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-9539 submitted by

MICHAEL HINTERMEYER 13501 NW FORD ROAD GASTON, OREGON 97119-8005.

The permit to be modified is Permit R-11739 with a date of priority of MAY 4, 1995. The permit allows the use of SPRINGS AND HAY CREEK, tributaries of TURNER CREEK, for STORAGE FOR IRRIGATION AND LIVESTOCK WATERING. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.4 ACRE-FEET(AF), BEING 0.2 AF FROM POND 1, 1.0 AF FROM POND 2, AND 0.2 AF FROM POND 3 EACH YEAR.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.
