On January 18, 1939, C. E. McUne, of Redmond, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water within the boundaries of the Central Oregon Irrigation District.

In the adjudication proceedings involving the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of the Central Oregon Irrigation District for the irrigation of, among other lands, 10 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 25 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 32 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 32 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 14 East, W. M.

The applicant herein proposes to transfer the water rights appurtenant to the above described lands to 15 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 19 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 32 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 23 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W. M.

The Central Oregon Irrigation District having submitted its approval to the proposed transfer, it appears that such change in place of use of water can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is APPROVED, and the water rights hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 10 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 25 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 32 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 32 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 14 East, W. M., be severed

therefrom and simultaneously, and without loss of priority, be transferred to 15 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 19 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 32 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 23 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W. M.

And it is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use within the time fixed for completion of the inchoate rights in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries.
