CORRECTING ORDER

The order of the Water Resources Director approving Temporary Transfer Application 9026, in the name of Bryan Schurter, was entered April 11, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 161. Condition 4 of the special order states that installation of a measuring device would be required prior to the diverting of water. After consulting with the District 16 Watermaster, it was determined that a measuring device would not be required for this transfer expect at such time the Watermaster finds it necessary. This order correctly describes Condition 4.

CONDITION 4 READ:

"Prior to the diverting of water, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department."

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

CONDITION 4 SHOULD READ:

"When required by the Watermaster, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department."

The order of the Water Resources Director approving Temporary Transfer Application 9026, in the name of Bryan Schurter, entered April 11, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 161 is CORRECTED as described herein. All other terms and conditions of the transfer approval order remain the same.
