On May 23, 1989, Rosella W. Baker, Trustee, submitted an affidavit that the Newel P. and Rosella W. Baker Trust is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the Baker Trust has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be cancelled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 55737, Volume 51, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Snow Creek Irrigation District. It is for the use of not to exceed 3.15 cubic feet per second of water from Three Creek, Snow Creek, and water stored under Permit R-701 in Big and Little Three Creek Lakes, with a date of priority of March 8, 1923 for Three Creek and Snow Creek and September 12, 1936 for the reservoirs. This is for the irrigation of 10.0 acres NW1/4 NW1/4 and 6.0 acres SW1/4 NW1/4, Section 10; supplemental irrigation of 13.5 acres SE1/4 SE1/4, Section 4; 39.5 acres NE1/4 NE1/4, 38.1 acres SE1/4 NE1/4, 12.4 acres NE1/4 SE1/4, Section 9; 2.8 acres SW1/4 NW1/4, 22.0 acres NW1/4 SW1/4, 9.6 acres SW1/4 SW1/4, Section 10; all in Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right described by the certificate recorded at page 55737, Volume 51, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled.
