ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6924 submitted by

MURIEL DITCHEN 6866 WACONDA ROAD NE SALEM, OREGON 97305.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 27709, was perfected under Permit 24352 with a date of priority of JULY 20, 1956. The right allows the use of the PUDDING RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 81.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE% SE%, as projected within PARKER DLC 49, SECTION 6, T 6 S, R 1 W, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

The applicant proposes to divert the water for use in Section 4 from the Pudding River into an unnamed stream and re-divert the water in the SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 4, T 6 S, R 1 W, WM; 1380 FEET SOUTH AND 1050 FEET EAST FROM THE W¼ CORNER, SECTION 4. The applicant proposes to control the diverted water by means of a dam located in the NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 5, T 6 S, R 1 W, WM; 710 FEET SOUTH AND 580 FEET WEST FROM THE W¼ CORNER, SECTION 4.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, including the water put into and taken out of the unnamed stream. The types and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 27709 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
