IN THE NATTER OF THE CANCELATION OF A GROUND SATER REGISTRATION CLAIMED RIGHT IN THE NAME OF WELSON LEE GILMOUR

ORDER

On September 13, 1967, Welson Lee Gilmour submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in a certificate of registration; that he has abandoned said claim of water right and requests the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 102 gallons per minute from a well located S. 16° 30' W. 1206 feet from the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a beginning date of 1948, for irrigation of 4.2 acres in NEW NWW, 3.0 acres in SEW NWW, and 1.0 acre in SWW NWW, Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and is described in the certificate of registration recorded at Volume 13, page 3092, Cround Water Registration Records.

That part of the claimed right for the use of not to exceed 398 gallons per minute from the described well for irrigation of 25.8 acres in NEW NWW and 6.0 acres in SEW NWW, Section 23, Township 11 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and described in said certificate, is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDETED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 102 gallons per minute from a well located S. 16° 30' W. 1206 feet from the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a beginning date of 1948, for irrigation of 4.2 acres in NE% NW%, 3.0 acres in SE% NW%, and 1.0 acre in SW% NW%, Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 4 West, W.M., is canceled.
