Transfer Application B-152, in the name of Newel P. and Rosella Baker, proposed a change in place of use of water from Snow Creek, Three Creek, and storage from Big and Little Three Creek Lakes under a certain right with a priority date of 1891, for irrigation of 39.5 acres NE1/4 NE1/4, 25.0 acres SE1/4 NE1/4, Section 9, 17.5 acres NW1/4 NW1/4, 16.5 acres SW1/4 NW1/4, 16.5 acres NW1/4 SW1/4, Section 10, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM. Said transfer also proposed a change in place of use from Snow Creek and Three Creek under priority of March 8, 1923 and storage from Big and Little Three Creek Lakes under priority of September 12, 1936 for irrigation of 5.0 acres SE1/4 SE1/4, Section 4, 7.5 acres NW1/4 NW1/4, 13.7 acres SW1/4 NW1/4, and 16.5 acres NW1/4 SW1/4, Section 10, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered May 9, 1980, approving Transfer Application B-152, provided that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use a certificate of water right be issued to the applicants.

On May 23, 1989, Rosella W. Baker, Trustee for Newel P. and Rosella W. Baker Trust, submitted an affidavit that the Baker Trust has abandoned the water right and request it be cancelled.

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order and continued. Therefore, the subject water right has been lost.
