ORDER

Now at this time this matter coming on before the State Engineer for consideration, and it appearing that under Certificate #3701, issued by the State Engineer upon the completion of the water right under permit 656, a water right was confirmed for the diversion of 1.34 second feet of water from Dry Creek and a storage reservoir constructed under permit R106, certificate 3889, for the irrigation of 107 acres of land under priority of March 29, 1911; that included in said 107 acres of land were the following tracts:

20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
2 Acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

that the subdivisions last described have been sold by the applicant herein to the Pacific Live Stock Company, such conveyance reserving the water rights to the grantor; that application is now made to transfer said rights for the use and benefit of the following described lands:


10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
16 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
16 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
